



AIDS MEMORIAL QUILT

We are so fortunate to be able to share in the Quilt's powerful stories of activism, love, healing, hope and remembrance and connect the story of HIV/AIDS to the important issues impacting our nation today.

This year on World AIDS Day, the National AIDS Memorial is partnering with Quilt Host organizations from around the country to bring more than 400 sections of the Quilt to communities across the country and once again <u>MHR</u> is one of those communities.



As the largest community arts project in the world, the AIDS Memorial Quilt is a teaching tool to help educate people about the story of AIDS, remember the more than 700,000 U.S. lives lost to disease, and to support local HIV/AIDS service organizations, LGBTQ+ centers, and support awareness about health and social justice issues.



The Quilt is a powerful teaching tool that shares the story of HIV/AIDS -- the 700,000 lives lost in this country alone – and the hope, healing, activism and remembrance that it inspires. It is an honor and a privilege to present a block of the Quilt on World AIDS Day and to display it in our sanctuary.
